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Allocation of seats:

The Total Intake per year is 150.

- I. **50% seats, ie. 75 seats out of total 150 seats in the Kerala Medical College, Cherpulassery, Palakkad will be filled up by the Educational Agency as allotted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations (CEE) from the list of candidates who have qualified in the Kerala Engineering Agriculture Medical Entrance Examination 2016 (KEAM 2016), in accordance with merit and reservation principles followed by Government from time to time.**
- II. **15% of total seats are reserved as NRI seats (i.e., 22 seats out of 150 seats) to be filled by the Management from eligible applicants who are children/dependents of Non Resident Indian, as per the conditions stipulated in GO(MS) No.34/2013/H&FWD dated 05.02.2013, GO(MS) No.193/2013/H&FWD dated 22.05.2013 and GO(MS) No.243/2014/H&FWD dated 06.08.2014. An applicant who depends upon his/her father/Mother/Brothers and Sisters (inclusive of first cousins) of Father or Mother/Half Brother/Half Sister/Adopted Father or Adopted Mother working abroad. The College shall admit and fill up 15% seats (i.e., 22 seats out of 150 seats) on the basis of inter-se merit of the applications based on the ranking in the NEET Entrance Examinations 2016.**
- III. **The College shall admit and fill up 30% seats (i.e.45 seats out of 150 seats) on the basis of inter-se merit of the applications based on the ranking in the NEET Entrance Examinations 2016.**
- IV. **As relevant reservation rules of the Govt. of Kerala are being applied to the 50% Govt. Merit Quota Seats, reservation principles will not be applicable to the balance 50% Seats in Management and NRI Quota.**
- V. **5% seats, ie. 8 seats out of total 150 seats will be allotted to the dependents of Trustees & Management and the Dependents of Staff/Employees of the sponsored Trust /Sister Concerns /Societies etc. of the Educational Agency and the Educational Agency shall be entitled to fill up these seats from among the NEET qualified applications received by the Agency.**
- VI. **To be eligible to apply for admission to MBBS courses, the candidate should have secured a minimum of marks at 50th percentile in National Eligibility-Cum-Entrance Test to MBBS Courses held for this academic year (NEET-2016).**
- VII. **However, the criteria of eligibility in NEET 2016 in respect of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, the minimum of marks to be obtained by the candidates shall be at 40th percentile and in respect of candidates with locomotory disability of lower limbs, the minimum of marks to be secured shall be at 45th percentile.**



- VIII. Furnishing of false information / particulars would result in the forfeiture of the candidature as well as cancellation of admission to the course if admitted and in addition, will attract the relevant provisions of criminal law of the land.
- IX. The details of all applications received including marks, etc. will be published on the website of the College. Applicants are directed to verify the details and notify entry mistakes, if any within the stipulated date. All genuine mistakes would be corrected. No further requests for changes will be entertained.
- X. Thereafter, merit list of the different categories will be published on the website of the college. Selection will be strictly be in the order of merit. Selected applicants will not be intimated by post. Therefore, the applicants are advised to refer to the website of the college and appear for the interview and final selection at the college without fail.
- XI. The date of commencement of the Course and the last date of admission process will be as per the time schedule fixed by the Government of India / Medical Council of India / Supreme Court of India.
- XII. The Dean or Head of the Institution/Management shall submit the list of candidates along with documents/certificates before the Admission Supervisory Committee as and when called for.

Eligibility Criteria

Nationality:

Candidate must be a citizen of India.

Qualification:

1. As prescribed in the regulations of the Medical Council of India.
2. Must have qualified in the National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (UG) of 2016 conducted by the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi.

Note (i). Rounding off of the percentage of marks to the nearest whole number is not permitted.

Note (ii). Candidates who have passed their qualifying examination other than from Kerala Higher Secondary Board, the CBSE or the ICSE shall produce equivalency / eligibility certificate obtained from the Kerala University of Health Sciences



Age

Shall complete the age of seventeen years on or before 31st December 2016.

The upper age limit is 25 years as on 31st December of the year of the examination. Further provided that this upper age limit shall be relaxed by a period of 5 (five) years for the candidates of Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes/ Other Backward Classes.

Admission

a. The Management will have the right to deny admission to any applicant, if it is found that the character and antecedent of the applicant are questionable on genuine grounds. In such cases, the reasons for the same will be recorded and communicated to the applicant concerned.

b. Candidates are advised to visit the website of the college.

www.keralamedicalcollege.com regularly for announcements and instructions, and to appear for interview and verification of documents and admission as notified there in. No separate communication will be sent to candidates in this connection. No T.A or any other allowance will be paid to attend the interview. No marks will be allotted at the interview.

c. Selected candidates shall take admission at the appointed time and date in the college after paying the tuition fee and other fees to be paid for the first year and produce Bank Guarantee obtained from Nationalized Bank agreeing to pay Rs. 1100000/- (Rupees Leven lakhs) per year on or before the first day of August of the year concerned towards tuition fee for the subsequent four years (2017, 2018, 2019 & 2020). No extension of time for payment of fees for the first year or for production of Bank Guarantee for the subsequent years or for making the security deposit will be allowed under any circumstances.

d. All candidates (including the SC/ST/SEBC candidates) will have to pay the fees, security deposit and produce Bank Guarantee at the time of admission itself

- 1.1. **Annual Tuition Fee will be Rs.11,00,000/- (Rupees Eleven Lakhs Only) for Management Quota seats. Annual Tuition Fee for NRI seats will be Rs.15,00,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Lakhs Only)-as per GO (Rt) No: 2463/2016/H & FWD Dated : 01/09/2016.**
- 1.2. **Annual tuition fee for the 50% students allotted by commissioner for entrance examinations as fixed by Govt of kerala as per the GO (Rt) No: 2463/2016/H & FWD Dated : 01/09/2016 .**

- 1.3. In addition to this, applicants need to pay an amount not exceeding one year's Tuition Fee as interest free deposit at the time of admission. It shall be refunded at the end of the course without interest.
- 1.4. Apart from the Tuition fee, applicants will have to pay caution deposit, fees payable to the Universities, Government, Medical Council of India, examination conducting charges, transportation charges, establishment charges, extracurricular, other statutory charges, etc.
- 1.5. Annual tuition fees and other fees should be paid on or before 1st August of every year for 5 years. Late payments will attract penalty.
- 1.6. Fee once paid will not be refunded.
- 1.7. The selected candidates at the time of admission shall remit the fees for the first year of the course fixed by the College and the interest free refundable deposit and submit a Bank Guarantee for covering the tuition fee for the remaining years of the MBBS Course. **No concession or exemption from payment of fee and deposit and submission of Bank Guarantee will be granted to the applicants.**



- 1.8. All fee payable at the time of admission shall be paid by way of DD favouring Kerala Medical College payable at Cherpulassery.
- 1.9. Fee concession will be given to the selected candidates below poverty line. Number of such concessions will be limited to 10% of the seat in the State Merit other than the seat reserved for National Merit and Children of Staff. Such candidates should be eligible for admission, in the order of their rank, in General Merit. There will be no separate reservation for such categories. The management reserves the right to deny the claims for such concessions, if found not genuine.
- 1.10. All students, including the SC/ST/OBC candidates, will have to pay the same fee as shown in this prospectus.

2. Late and Incomplete applications will be rejected. The College will not be responsible for delayed delivery of application.
3. No Reservation of seat for SC, ST and OBC.
4. Furnishing of false information/particulars would result in the forfeiture of the candidature as well as cancellation of admission to the course if admitted and in addition, will attract the relevant provisions of criminal law of the land.
5. Candidates eligible for reservations/ privileges under the category concerned shall furnish details thereof in the respective column of the application and attach proof as required to be produced in support of the claim under clause 1b. Any such claim not supported by proper proof will not make any applicant eligible for reservations/ privileges under that category.
6. Applicants are instructed not to enclose any original certificates along with the application.



PROCEDURE OF SELECTION

a. Subject to any orders that may be passed by the competent Courts, admission will be only on the basis of inter-se merit as per total marks/percentile score obtained by the applicant in the National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (UG) of 2016 conducted by the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi.

b. The Common merit list as well as the Community merit list will be published on the website of the college www.keralamedicalcollege.com and notice board of the college. Therefore, the candidates are advised to refer to the website of the college and appear for the interview and document verification at the time and place notified without fail. No intimation will be issued to the candidates by post.

Furnishing of false information:

Furnishing of false information/particulars would result in the forfeiture of the candidature as well as cancellation of admission to the course, if admitted, and in addition, will attract the relevant provisions of criminal law of the land.

CODE OF CONDUCT

a. Every student shall adhere strictly to the code of conduct of the college. Students who violate the code of conduct are liable for disciplinary action including expulsion from the college.
